**What does the Crested Butte Rotary Club really do?** Of course, many residents and visitors are familiar with our sole fundraising event – the annual Rubber Duckie Race. This fundraiser raises over \$40,000 from the Duckie Race proceeds.

**The Community Need is Growing:** The Duckie Race is not enough – the youth in our community need our support and we need to increase our scholarship fund to stay in step with the increasing student population. Twenty students was a large graduating class 5 years ago, the graduating class of 2014 is well over forty students and there are over seventy students in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade.
