#### **Scholarship Application**

The Rotary Club of Crested Butte/Mt. Crested Butte is pleased you plan to continue your education. We encourage you to apply for a Rotary Scholarship as we (Scholarship Committee) judge each application on its merit. It is your responsibility to complete this application and to follow each of the procedures listed below.

**Award:** We will award scholarships to local high school seniors who either attend CBCS, or are home schooled. We will be awarding scholarships based on any or all of the following criteria:

- 1. Financial need.
- 2. Academic and extracurricular merit.
- 3 Service above self

The scholarships are intended to assist in obtaining an undergraduate degree from a university, college or training in other accredited schools of higher education. The Scholarship Committee requires each scholarship recipient to begin his/her post secondary education in the fall term immediately following high school graduation. A portion be set aside for a second year scholarship. Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the institution of your choice for the upcoming academic year.

#### **Procedures**

- 1. Neatly complete the attached application form.
- 2. Two (2) letters of recommendation must be submitted with the application. To include:
  - a. One (1) letter from a teacher or coach
  - b. One (1) letter from a personal acquaintance, employer or clergy from outside the school
- 3. Submit a current copy of your transcript with the application.
- 4. Submit a copy of your resume.
- 5. Submit a copy of your college application essay and what the prompt was.
- 6. Submit a personal letter, maximum of one page, telling the committee:
  - a. Your goals and objectives for the future
  - b. Why you feel you should be awarded a Rotary Scholarship
  - c. In a short paragraph describe one very important/ memorable activity that you were most proud of during your high school career
- 7. A personal interview conducted by the Scholarship Committee members will be required. The dates for the interviews will be held at the end of March Applicants and College Guidance office will be notified.
- 8. Rotary Scholarship Recipients and parent(s) are encouraged to attend the Rotary Recognition Breakfast. The time, date and location of this breakfast will be provided at a later date.
- 9. Awards will be awarded at the CBCS Awards Banquet.
